The text should be given in English using MS Word formats (12-point font Times New Roman, 1.0 line spacing). The text should not occupy more than one full A4 page (margins: top, bottom, and left – 3 cm, right – 2 cm). The title should be written in CAPITAL LETTERS at the beginning of the abstract (bold font, 1.5 line spacing). Next line – author(s) name(s) (1.5 line spacing) and affiliation(s) (1.0 line spacing). The next line should be blank. After this line the text should be placed.

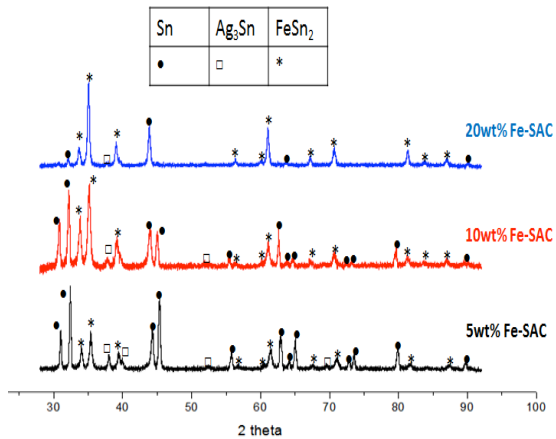


Figure 1. XRD spectra of melted Fe-SAC 305 samples.
